4. Specify the type of Content request: Reprint or Adaptation
5. Specify initiative for which you wish to request Content (detail event title, conference, etc.)
6. Specify how you wish to make the Content available within your initiative (printed, online, etc.)?
7. Specify the anticipated number of Content copies or estimated scope of distribution
